


In Stitches: Steph's Spring Clover Sashiko Pattern

Sashiko is a Japanese form of embroidery which uses running stitch to create beautiful patterns.

Use this pattern to stitch your own sashiko clover >




For this project you will need:

- Cotton or linen fabric. I used some green Kofu Tsumugi fabric.
- Sashiko thread.
- A sashiko needle.
- Scissors.
- Embroidery tracing paper.
- A pen.

No embroidery hoop necessary!
