

The Whitworth in Stitches: Steph's Summer Rose Sashiko Pattern

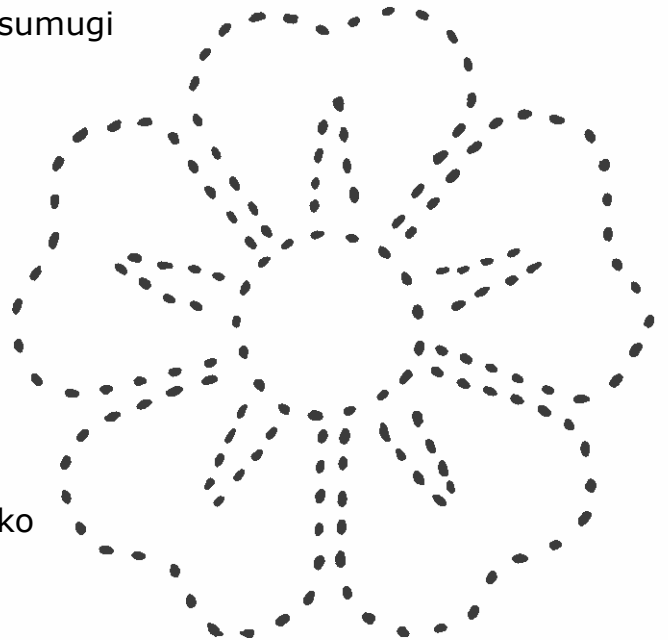
Sashiko is a Japanese form of embroidery which uses simple stitches to create beautiful patterns.

For this project, you will need:

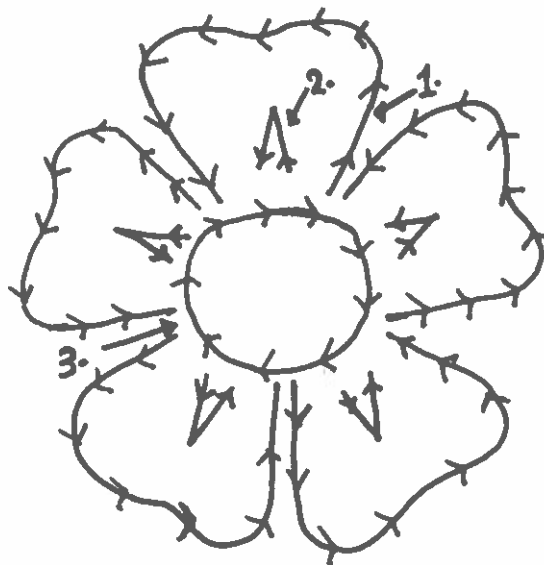
- Cotton or linen fabric. I used red Kofu Tsumugi fabric.
- Sashiko thread.
- A sashiko needle.
- Scissors.
- Embroidery tracing paper.
- A needle.

No embroidery hoop necessary!

Use this pattern to stitch your own sashiko rose >
